
What Cigars do Young People Smoke?

 Use PATH data to calculate which brands, formats and flavors are consumed by Under 21s


Where were T21 laws put into place?

 Collect data from Colston et al, 2021, CDC-STATE, and Tobacco21.org on T21 details and population coverage Did T21 laws decrease sales of cigars?

- Estimate Under 21
 Consumption Shares
- Diff-in-Differences analyses of T21 on format level sales




Under 21 Shares of Cigar Consumption PATH Waves 1-5



 Distribution of Under 21 Shares by Product across 19 Nielsen States from March 2017 to November 2021

CSDID Models



- Callaway and Sant'Anna
 Difference in Differences Model
- Use State-Level T21 policies
- Average Treatment Effect on Treated
- Cigarillos
 - -10.2% (95%CI -3.7%- -16.7%)
- Traditional Cigars
 - -7.9% (95%CI -0.6%- -15.1%)
- Filtered Cigars
 - -13.2% (95%CI -3.6%- -22.8%)



- Under 21 Cigar Consumption Share
 Under 21 Cigarette Consumption
 Share
- Cigarillos appear to be the favored format for Under 21s
- Tobacco 21 likely decreased cigar sales
 - Effect sizes are currently too large for my comfort



- Traditional Difference-in-Differences model leveraging differential Under 21 shares and T21 Policy Details
- Models with appropriate controls
 - Weather, Economy, COVID, Price, Smoking Bans
